

MEETING REPORT: -

Polio-Plus Movie Night.

In lieu of our normal weekly meeting at the Country Club, members joined in with the other Wagga-based Rotary Clubs and met at the Forum Six Cinema Complex last Tuesday, with partners and guests, to enjoy the premier showing of the movie 'Ride Like a Girl'. The objective being to raise funds for Rotary's major project to rid our world of Polio-Myelitis.



The evening was very well attended, with only 'a handful' of vacant seats – and we believe that they had, indeed been purchased, but for reasons unknown the purchasers were unable to attend on that evening.

Our own Elaine Almond, in her role of Assistant District Governor, welcomed all and provided a succinct summary of Rotary Internationals efforts in this important field. She also spoke glowingly of the support that the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation provide in this cause.

The movie tells the story of Michelle Payne who, in 2015, became the first female jockey to win a Melbourne Cup on Prince of Penzance. The film stared Sam Neil, Teresa Palmer & Sullivan Stapleton and was directed by Rachel Griffiths who is quoted as saying that Ride Like a Girl has the potential to be 'the greatest Australian sports story'. It is 'a PG feminist sports film that will make men cry'. Whilst the jury is still out' on this objective, the movie was most enjoyable with the most common description reported being 'delightful'.

It was an evening enjoyed by those in attendance and we will report the resultant funds raised for this worthy cause as soon as this information becomes available.
