- ➤ Ellen Brasier gave a report on the District Conference held at Temora last weekend.






Events we can support:-

David Payne spoke to us about Joseph Barbera. Thursday 24th March was the anniversary of the birth of Joseph Barbera, who with William Hanna founded the animation studio and production company of Hanna-Barbera in1937, Barbera, an animator, director, producer, storyboard artist and cartoonist met William Hanna in California while working at MGM Studios. When MGM dissolved their animation department they co-founded Hanna-Barbera and went on to produce such successful TV shows as The Flintstones, Yogi Bear, Scooby-Doo, Top Cat, The Smurfs, Huckleberry Hound and the Jetsons.



Barbera died in 2006 of natural causes at the age of 95 thus ending a career of 70 years in animation. David then went on to hold a quiz in The Flintstones, The Simpsons, Blondie, The Jetsons and SpongeBob-Squarepants.
