Thursday 28th April – Renas Khalef will outline his story – his background as a refugee from oppression in his home country and his hopes for the future in Australia

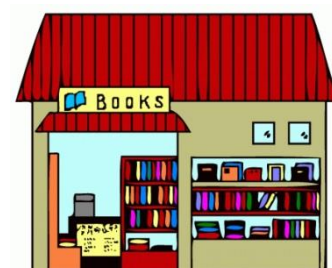
Thursday 5th May – Book Fair Planning night.

Book Fair.

Well we are approaching the sticky end of the Book Fair year. Three weeks from this coming Thursday night we will be engaged in transporting stock and displaying at the Hall. Advertising is being organized with Daily Advertiser, signage sites around town booked, Posters and flyers being printed for distribution, hall signage being updated, & outside helpers sought for stock uplift on Thursday 12th May. etc. So be ready to become involved. 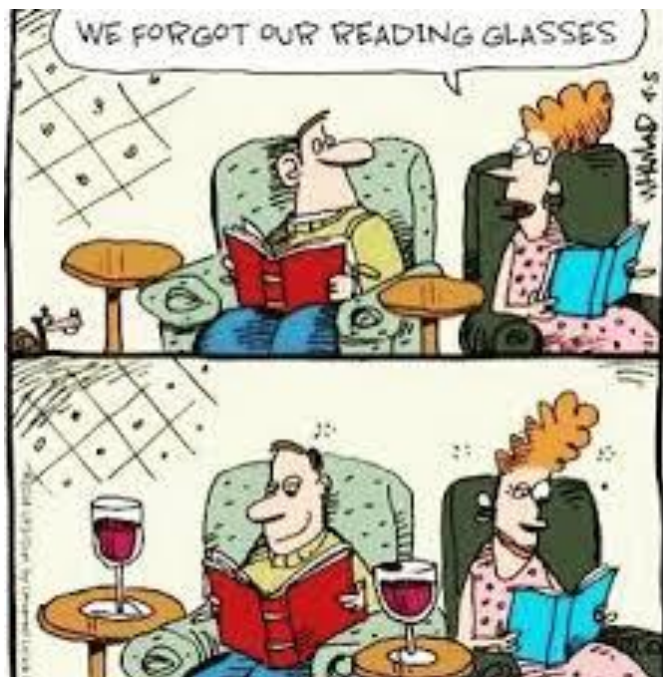
